SgtMaj Santiago has served in the Marine Corps for 29 years in numerous units throughout his career, they include; Marine Corps Security Forces, Marine Barracks, Guam; 3d Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, Camp Pendleton, California with deployments to Okinawa, Japan, on the Unit Deployment Program and with the 31st Marine Expeditionary Unit; 1st Recruit Training Battalion as a Drill Instructor, Senior Drill Instructor and Series Gunnery Sergeant with Alpha Company; 3d Maintenance Battalion, 3d Force Service Support Group as the Maintenance Management Officer, Okinawa, Japan; The United States Naval Academy as an Assistant Marine Officer Instructor, Company Senior Enlisted Leader for 19th Company and subsequently the US Naval Academy Drill Master.
